



Bible Verse Memorization Tips



Tip #1

Provide something visual to reinforce the overall idea of the Bible verse.

Tip #2

Let your children see YOU memorizing inspirational Bible verses.

Parents are the strongest role models in children's lives. What they see you doing makes a huge impact on them. When your children are working on a memory verse, you should be memorizing the same one. Let them see you working on it.

Tip #3

Help your children have repeated exposure to the Bible verse they're memorizing.

Make some extra cards with the Bible verses, using picture helps if your child cannot yet read. Slip one into your children's lunchboxes so they can study their Bible verse while they eat, or put them up in the bathroom, on a bedroom mirror...

Laminate and hole-punch a memory card, then attach it to one of those clips that kids like to put on their backpacks. You know they'll see it frequently this way. They can even look at it while waiting for the school bus.

Tip #4

Be sure to **PRAY** for your children to not only be successful at memorizing each verse, but to understand it, apply it in their lives, and grow closer to the Lord Jesus Christ because of it.
